8. From your OMC bookshelf, tap a title to begin reading or listening.

The option to renew becomes available three days before the title is set to expire and appears next to the title on your Bookshelf under your Library Account. Look for the **Green Renew icon**. You can only use the renew feature once for each title you've borrowed.

Installing the App

Open the Marketplace on your phone

Enter 'OverDrive Media Console' into the search bar.

Tap **install** from the app's description page.



Sign in with your Windows Live ID. [If you do not have an ID, create one here](#)

How it works

1. Open OverDrive Media Console (OMC) for Windows Phone.



2. Swipe from left to right for the 'get books' screen.

3. Tap a library on your list to open its digital collection website. If your list is empty, or you need to add a new library, tap [find a library](http://help.overdrive.com/article/0329/How-to-use-the-Get-Books-feature-of-OverDrives-mobile-app-for-Windows-Phone) (<http://help.overdrive.com/article/0329/How-to-use-the-Get-Books-feature-of-OverDrives-mobile-app-for-Windows-Phone>)

4. When your library website opens, find a title to borrow by tapping one from the home page or running a search.

How it works (cont.)

5. Tap a title, then click **Borrow** to check it out. If prompted, sign in.



6. Your bookshelf opens, displaying title(s) you have checked out. From here, tap **Download** to download the title to OMC.



7. Tap **ok**, then **ok** again to open your OMC bookshelf.
