The fourth annual ***Dewey Classic*** Miniature Golf Tournament will be held at the Jonathan Bourne Public Library on Sunday, March 4, 2012. Players of all ages will play on the 18 hole course set up throughout the building. As usual, a raffle and the 19th Hole Café will be set up in the large meeting room. This year, we are excited about the addition of a Saturday “Teen Night Out” where Middle and High School aged students will be able to play unlimited mini golf and enjoy a pizza party at the library.

We would like to extend the opportunity for you to participate in this fun community event as a sponsor of a hole or tee. Your donation will help support our ***Concerts on the Lawn*** series held during July and August. These shows in turn become a fundraiser for the Bourne Food Pantry with the cost of admission being a donated item to that organization. Please help us keep this popular music series going.

In return for your donation to the Dewey Classic:

- Your name/logo will be showcased at your sponsored hole, or tee.
- Space will be available at your sponsored hole for you to greet players at the event and/or provide information about your business or service.
- Your name/logo will be included on the take home scorecard.
- Your name/logo will be listed on the library website with a link to your own website.
- Your materials will be available in the library for 30 days after the event. (on average, 350 people come into the library daily)
- Promotion will be given to all sponsors in the library newsletter, local media, and library displays
- Sponsors will be able to provide “course obstacles” to help promote their business on their sponsored hole or tee.

Last year, nearly 400 people came to the library to play mini-golf raising nearly \$3,000 for the day’s events. With these funds, the library was able to hold seven concerts, including folk, blue-grass, and Celtic Harp. This year, our goal is to double that figure so that we can provide programs not only in the summer but all year long.
